Dear Siblings in Christ,

Each year, summer seems to move by more quickly. This year we have had so much rain that much of the time we have been stuck indoors. After the mild winter we enjoyed, I'm not complaining. Earlier this year, many thought it would be a dry year because we didn't see much snow over the winter—I guess you really can't predict the weather.

So it goes with ministry: we cannot predict what will happen. Even so, we spend a lot of time trying to predict and control.



In my sermon last Sunday, I mentioned the term "functional atheism," and it seemed to resonate with some of you: The modern educator Parker Palmer defines "functional atheism" as a belief that ultimate responsibility for everything rests with me."

As I preached on Sunday, "functional atheism" might seem like it's unharmful—until you find yourself in the middle of a literal or figurative storm of which you have no control. We know we are not in control, however, we like to pretend that we are in control, because believing the illusion makes us more comfortable.

So much of our lives are spent trying to be comfortable. There's nothing wrong with that—and also, we as followers of Jesus know that we are called to something greater than our own comfort: we are invited to love and serve others as Jesus serves us. We are gifted with the grace God offers so that we may share that grace with others.

God is in control. And we are along on the journey. And that is a beautiful place to be. I leave you with encouragement from Psalm 27:14, "Wait on the Lord: be of good courage and God will strengthen your heart."

Dear ones, be of good courage! Remember God is with you!

Question: There are some conflicts with the proposed times, for example there will be COG people here until 10:30. At least half of the fellowship hall is taken over by the jumbo sale for the summer.

The storage room where the tables are have 3 shelves that need to be sorted through and could make space there. Two storage units in the brick room, one for fall festival one for Mike's tools.

\$1000 per month until 12/31/2024. Claire seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Sara Paine - parent led homeschool program (M-W 8:30am - 1pm). 1 classroom, kitchen, fellowship hall No longer needed.

NOT VIABLE: Hal Erks - Harbon Montessori (M-F 7am - 6pm). Been in New Brighton for 50 years.

3 classrooms. 20 students per classroom, nursery, fellowship hall. Year-round operations. Have been meeting at a small Christian church in New Brighton. Looking for new space. We cannot provide space year round. Not viable.

Building changes to help us practice our welcoming statement.

Move the AV equipment to the sanctuary—Ideas: remove 2 pews from the back to provide space for the AV equipment.

Mount projector(s) from the ceiling.

Custodial room needs updates.

Claire motions to release the nursery so it can be office/storage for FACC congregation. Library will be the quiet room/nursery temporarily. Nursery toys to be sold at the Jumbo sale. Will keep select (quiet) toys. Paula will get feedback from Rochelle Benson for ideas for the new space. Cassie and Paula will sort

through toys. Seconded by Karen, motion carried unanimously.
